Dear Mr. Hansen:

This is a Final Order issued by the Secretary of State (secretary) for your failure to file a timely first pre-election contribution and expenditure report for the May 18, 2004, Primary Election.

This contested case was heard before Hearings Officer Elizabeth Fulsher on August 16, 2004. The Secretary of State was represented by Lynn Rosik, Assistant Attorney General. Mr. Hansen appeared on his own behalf. Hearings Officer Fulsher issued a proposed order on August 21, 2004, and an opportunity to file written exceptions to the proposed order was provided. The deadline for written exceptions to be filed was September 20, 2004. No written exceptions were received by the secretary.

The Secretary of State, having considered the proposed order and the record in this matter, adopts the proposed order with the following exception:

Page one, paragraph one, incorrectly states the date of the telephone hearing as December 16, 2002, when in fact the hearing was held on August 16, 2004.

A copy of the proposed order is attached to and made part of this final order.

ORDER

It is ordered that a civil penalty of \$670.08 be assessed against James Neil Hansen, Treasurer.

RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW

You have the right to appeal this Order to the Oregon Court of Appeals pursuant to ORS 183.482. To appeal you must file a petition for judicial review with the Court of Appeals within 60 days from the day this Order was served to you. Because this Order was mailed to you, the date of service is the day it was *mailed*, not the day you received it. If you do not file a petition for judicial review within the 60-day time period, you will lose your right to appeal.
